A project of San Jose, the San Jose Environmental Innovation Center (SJEIC) will involve the renovation and new construction of a ±50,000 square foot community facility on a 4.2 acre site owned by the city near the downtown area. Promoted as a “living laboratory” for renewable energy, the completed project will host two nonprofit tenants, the Clean Technology Demonstration Center (CTDC) and Habitat for Humanity Restore. CTDC will provide laboratory, office, prototype manufacturing and demonstration space for emerging clean technology companies. The Habitat for Humanity ReStore will sell donated construction materials at a discounted price, with profits accruing to its Silicon Valley affiliate to strengthen its operating capacity. The facility will also include a household hazardous waste drop-off site, the first permanent one in Santa Clara County.
